Patient: Mr./Mrs. Campbell, a 51-year-old patient, presents with a swelling on his cheek and severe, persistent, throbbing toothache.

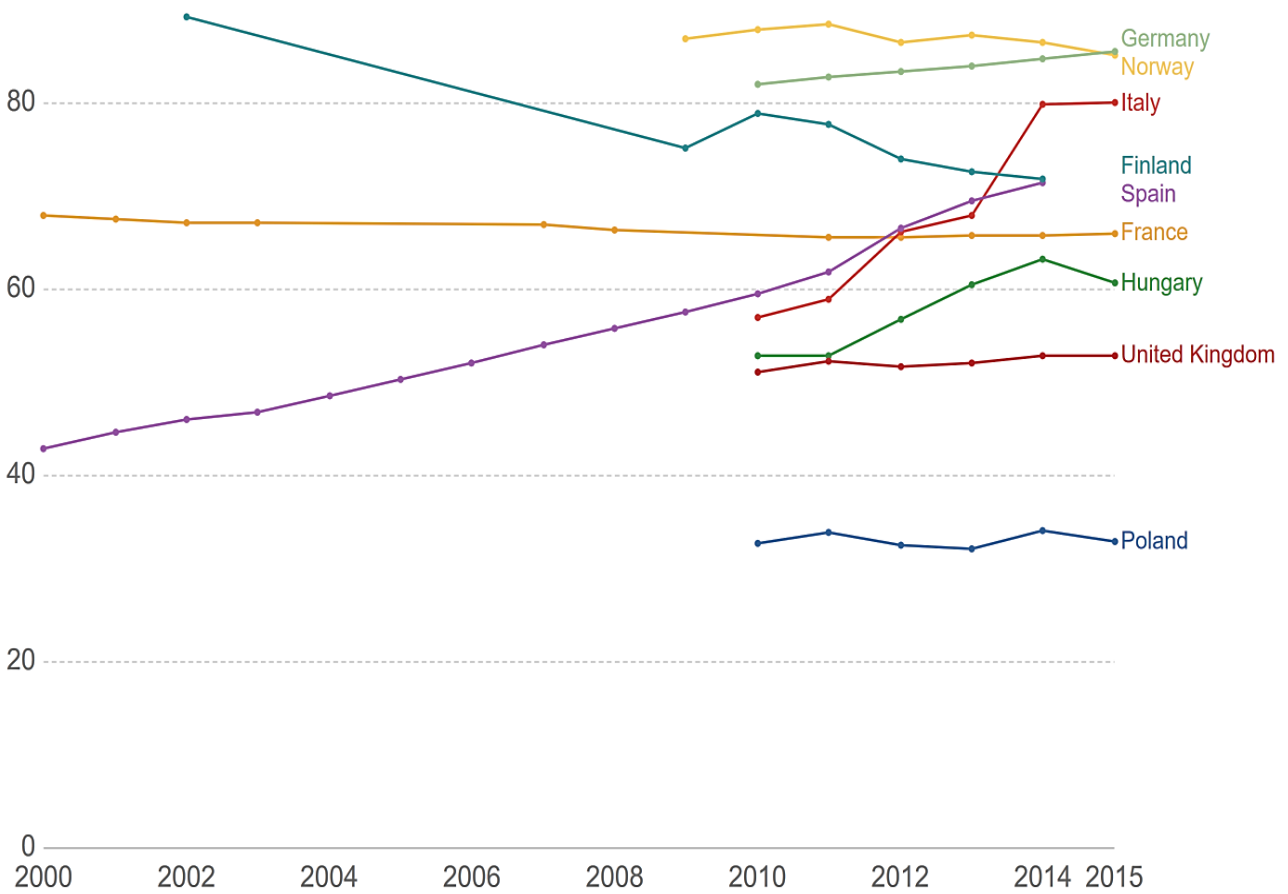
	TASK
Biodata	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Greet the patient and introduce yourself. - Find out about four pieces of biodata. - Signal that you move on to the chief concern.
Presenting complaints	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Clarify the nature of the complaint. - Enquire about the onset and duration of the complaint. - Find out more details about triggering and soothing factors.
Past medical history	<p>Ask the patient about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - respiratory disorders - diabetes, cardiovascular problems - epilepsy, allergies.
Past dental history	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Find out about the last dental visit. - Ask about previous oral dental surgeries. - Ask about the loss of teeth. - Explain the importance of regular visits.
Social and family history	<p>Ask the patient about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - smoking status and alcohol consumption - complementary therapies used. <p>Tell the patient the possible ways of dealing with this problem (antibiotics and root treatment).</p>
